

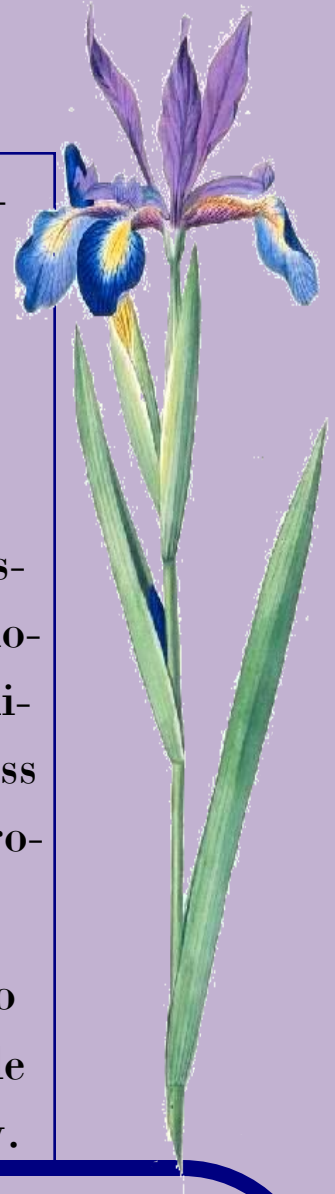
Relationship Violence on the North Shore
